In accordance with Condition E.13 of its Ohio Hazardous Waste Facility Installation and Operation Permit (the "Permit"), EnviroSAFE Services of Ohio, Inc. ("ESOI") hereby submits this progress report to the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency ("Ohio EPA") for the period beginning February 1, 2023 and ending February 28, 2023.

Corrective Measures Implementation ("CMI"):

Project Activities:

During this reporting period, CMI activities included the following:

1. The leachate extraction system remained off due to low temperatures with the exception of:
 - SWMU 5: NRP-24, NRP-31
 - SWMU 6: NRP-26, NRP-33
 - SWMU 7: NRP-35, NRP-30, DPW-18.

No maintenance activities were performed.

2. Solar Sipper – inspected and found to be operating as designed or off due to low temperature; and

Summary of All CMI-Related Contacts with the Public:

ESOI has not had any related contacts with the public during this reporting period.

Summary of Potential or Encountered Problems and Rectification Actions:

There is nothing to report in association with this topic for this reporting period.

Projected Work:

During the next reporting period it is anticipated that the following activities will occur:

1. Development of an O&M Plan for the newly installed SWMU 8 extraction wells and gas vents;
2. SWMU 9 Corrective Measures Completion of Work (CMCW) Report target first quarter 2023; and
3. Resume operation and maintenance of the leachate extraction systems on SWMUs 5, 6, and 7 when the temperature is routinely above 32 degrees Fahrenheit and wells are accessible for maintenance.
